WARNING

Effective immediately, any tenant who burns out a pedestal outlet **will be charged for the replacement part.**

This typically occurs by overloading power strips on your boat (for example, with 1500W blow dryers, space heaters, microwaves, etc.), which draws too much power from the 30amp pedestals. Defective power cords (i.e. not marine grade) are also a source of fires and burned-out plugs.
