Per the Contract for Private Wharfage, section 12 (which all tenants should have signed upon being accepted as a tenant to the marina):

"Companies and/or workers hired by the Owner to accomplish tasks aboard a vessel are required to sign in with the Marina office and execute a Premises Access Agreement. They are also required to carry liability insurance with minimum per occurrence policy limits of \$500,000, have a business license and provide worker compensation insurance for employees. Owner shall verify the existence of such insurance prior to permitting work aboard his/her vessel."
